

What is Van Deventer-Maas Stichting?

Van Deventer-Maas Stichting is a private foundation with a mission to support the education of Indonesian people.

The Stichting was founded in 1947, pursuant to a Provision in the last will of Mrs. Elizabeth Maas, widow of Mr. Coen van Deventer.

In 1979, the Van Deventer-Maas Stichting merged with Tandil Stichting (founded in 1913) and the Van Deventer Stichting (founded in 1917), thereby absorbing the Karnoi foundation, which had been founded in 1913.

Mr. Van Deventer, who was critical of the unequal financial relationship between the Netherlands and Indonesia, wrote an article "Debt of Honor" and initiated ethical policy, was focusing on the development and education of the Indonesia people.

The couple was childless; therefore, they decided to make their wealth available for the personal development of the Indonesia people. One of the supports given is scholarship for young, talented and financially deprived students.

Duration of Support

The scholarship starts from the 2nd year up to the standard duration of the study (e.g. S1 2nd-4th year) unless the/s/he is underperform (IPK < 3,00), on leave, and no confirmation of fund recipients; and no renews within a certain period of time.

The CRITERIAS to apply for a scholarship

1st-3rd year students of S1 and 1st-2nd year students of D3.

Max age is 27

Financially deprived (stated in SKTM and/or Recommendation letter of economy condition from Univ.)

IPK \geq 3,00

Disciplines: Accounting, Agriculture, Fishery/Animal Husbandry, Architecture, Arts and Cultures.

Arts and Design, Biology, Chemistry, Communication, Economics, Education, Engineering, English, Financial Management, Forestry, Geography, Sociology, Anthropology, Health/Medicine, History, Hotel Management, Informatics, Information Technology/ICT, Management, Mathematics,

Physics, Statistics, Technical/Technology

Active in organization and/or community

Proficiency in English will be an advantage.

Amount of Scholarship and Benefits

Rp. 420.000,- will be paid directly to the grantees' bank account every month on the same date (except weekend/holiday)

One time TOEFL (if any) and Graduation Bonus

Free Capacity Building

Enrolment Application Process

Van Deventer-Maas Stichting Scholarship enrolment must be completed online through www.vdmdata.org/ers. You can download the required documents checklist form. When you are completing the online registration, if you are invited to continue the process to the second step, then you must submit the complete required documents to the Person in Charge in your university.

The required documents are:

1. Surat Keterangan Tidak Mampu (SKTM) or Recommendation letter, which stating your economy condition from the School/University (Rector/Dean/Head of Study Program Department).
2. The latest academic transcript (IPK \geq 3,00)
3. Parents' guardian official income statement (for Institution/Private officers) max. last 2 months.
4. Parents' guardian statement of work and income (for entrepreneur) signed and seal with Rp.5.000,- and legalized by *Achiarahat*.
5. Copies of ID (KTM and KTP)
6. Copy of Family Card (KK)
7. Copy of your Bank Account (front page)
8. Electricity / telephone bill (max. last 2 months)
9. Photo 3x4 (2-tips)
10. An essay about yourself (including family, study and social activities and achievement), why VDMs must choose you to be one of the grantees, what would you gain if you were chosen as grantee, and what will you do for the society after you received the scholarship. (Min. 1,5 pages of A4, Font Times New Roman, size 11, and space 1)

The University will send the documents to Van Deventer Stichting Representative office in Yogyakarta to be comply with the above criteria. An agreement will be between you and the University on behalf of Van Deventer Stichting upon approval.
